

# COME THAI WITH ME!

OK! ENJOYS A DOUBLE DOSE OF REST AND RELAXATION IN PICTURE-PERFECT THAILAND



and seemingly endless unspoilt beaches, Thailand could easily be mistaken for paradise. While the country has plenty to offer holidaymakers in search of bustling big cities and a vibrant party scene, it's also the perfect choice for those wanting to get away from it all with a relaxing holiday. OK!'s Zoë Hill jetted off on a twin-centre break in search of rest and rejuvenation...

#### WHERE CAN I STAY?

OK! began our adventure at the Aleenta Hua Hin Resort & Spa in Pranburi, a 23-room boutique hotel a two-hour drive from Bangkok. The resort prides itself on its eco-friendly credentials - tastefully concealed solar panels provide energy, while waste water is recycled to irrigate the gardens and the hotel's 54-acre organic farm. We took a tour of the farm and saw fields of fresh produce, the fragrant herb garden and met the free-range chickens who laid our eggs for breakfast. Anything the hotel can't make or grow itself comes from within a 30km radius, along with all the staff. Our spacious room, complete with plunge pool, was footsteps from the almost deserted beach. Our favourite part of the day was waking up in time for the sunrise over the Gulf Of Thailand. The daily 5pm delivery of canapés to the room was our second favourite!

We hopped on a plane for an hour to round off our trip at the Aleenta Phuket Resort & Spa in Phang Na. Our villa at the all-suite resort boasted

- our four-poster bed was incredibly comfortable, but most of our time was spent outside, either relaxing on our day bed, swimming in our private pool or enjoying an al fresco bath. The beach-side

Natai restaurant was the perfect place to watch the sun set, with a daiquiri in hand, before dinner.

# WHICH STARS WILL I SEE?

Beckham enjoyed a family holiday with the kids there, while Nicole Kidman has also fallen for its charms. Kim Kardashian and her family holidayed in Phuket two years ago, where they went zip-lining and visited an orphanage.

#### WHAT CAN I EAT?

With a Michelin-starred chef as its general manager, the Aleenta Hua Hin prides itself on its food. Every dish on the menu has a number next to it, showing how far its ingredients have

travelled – the ingredients for our delicious larb mushroom (a Thai-style salad with mint leaves, shallots and lime juice) had only travelled 3.6km to our plate. We felt positively virtuous ordering the chocolate brownies and 'rice cream' (Okm), a dairy-free alternative to ice cream.

One of our favourite meals was also one of the simplest – a private barbecue on the beach. Under a gazebo, we enjoyed a salad from the hotel's farm and barbecued kebabs with giant prawns caught earlier that day. The only lights came from

a candle on our table and the green glow of the squid fishermen's boats in the distance, while the only sound was the waves lapping on the shore.

Explore the nearby area and the local cuisine with a street food tour – we hopped aboard the hotel's tuk-tuk to sample some amazing tom kha kai (chicken in coconut soup), spicy pork and banana fritters, with a refreshing Thai beer between each stop

In Phuket, we signed up for the hotel's wellness package, featuring light and healthy menu options without sacrificing any of the taste. Highlights included the coconut oats with a pineapple and mint smoothie for breakfast and the coconut and mango panna cotta for dessert.

#### WHERE CAN I RELAX?

Our spa experience began as soon as we were picked up at the airport with a 'spa transfer'. We took our seat in the vehicle's massage chair and shut our eyes as we enjoyed a head, neck and shoulder massage, a foot massage and a nap on the drive from Bangkok. Once we arrived, we saw the Ayurah Spa follows the same fresh, local ethos as the hotel's food menu. We enjoyed a divine facial where our skin was cleansed with yoghurt and treated with a gentle scrub and a tamarind mask

before cooling cucumber strips were laid over the face to soothe the skin. We also enjoyed a miracle grain body wrap, where we were rubbed with seven types of rice, yoghurt and buffalo milk, then left to drift off as we were encased in banana leaves.

In Phuket, the jewel in the spa's crown is a Linda Meredith facial – the brand is a favourite

with the A-list, with Gwyneth Paltrow among her fans. We enjoyed the haute couture facial, which is tailored to your individual needs. After a deep cleanse, steam and extraction, an exfoliating serum was applied, followed by a mask. It's fair to say we were glowing by the time we left!




#### WHAT ELSE MUST I DO?

work on tom yum soup, green papaya salad, pad Thai and mango sticky rice. The chef was encouraging about our efforts, and the empty plates suggested the exercise had been a success.

One of the highlights of our trip was a visit to a turtle sanctuary, the Phang Nga Coastal Fisheries Research And Development Centre. We learned all about the great work they do looking after injured turtles and made friends with one

turtle on the day of his release. We even got to set him down on the sand a few feet from the shore, before watching him take his first

steps into the Andaman Sea, before swimming away to start his new life.

#### HOW DO I GET THERE?

A five-night wellbeing break starts from £1,149pp. Price includes two nights at the Aleenta Hua Hin (www.aleenta.com/huahin) with breakfast, three nights at the Aleenta Phuket (www.aleenta.com/phuket) on a wellness package, plus two cooking classes, two yoga sessions, two massages and two facials.


